Camp Cherokee Day Camps are an enriching cultural and academic experience for Cherokee and other Native American students residing in Cherokee Nation. The camps will include cultural activities, games, fitness programs and informational sessions about healthy living. Each camp will be available to 200 students entering grades 1-9. Students will be divided into groups by age and placed in a morning and afternoon class. The late afternoon hours will provide time for recreation, enrichment and large camp events.

Camp Cherokee 2011 will be located in five locations to better serve our native children. In addition to the day camp a residential Arts and STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Math) camp will be held at Sequoyah Schools in Tahlequah July 10-15, more information about all the camps are available on the Camp Cherokee web site.

These camps are offered at no cost. Space is limited so apply early.

Applications will be available Monday April 4 and due by May 6.
