#1: Comprehensive-Downtown revitalization is a complex process and cannot be

accomplished through the completion of a single project. For successful long-term revitalization, a comprehensive approach must be utilized!

#2: Incremental-

Small projects and simple activities lead to a more sophisticated understanding of the revitalization

process and help to develop skills so that more complex problems can be addressed and more ambitious projects can be

Ages 0-6 years old-judging begins at 6:30


Ages 7-adult-judging begins at 7 pm
